

CATECHISTS are dedicated people in our Parish who help bring God's message to hundreds of students in our State schools - Lane Cove Primary, Lane Cove West Primary and Greenwich Primary School.

Our catechists are fully trained and supported for this vitally important ministry in our Parish. Classes are held weekly and we would welcome your participation for a term, a year or longer.

The Children's Liturgy supports children in the development of their faith with stories and activities in the Parish Hall.

THE CHILDREN'S LITURGY is held during the 9:30am Sunday Mass in school terms.

Children are escorted to the Parish Hall shortly after Mass commences. They are split into two groups – 3-6 years and 7 years and older, with programs designed for each group. The children are escorted back to the Church in time for the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Volunteers lead and assist the Children's liturgy groups (comprehensive support materials are provided).

The **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS** is a feature of parish life at St Michael's. It helps adults learn more about the Catholic faith and become Catholics.

The RCIA meets weekly (except during school holidays). Volunteers to support the RCIA program are welcome.

Outreach

St Michael's **SOCIAL JUSTICE GROUP** aims to make a difference to members of our immediate and wider community. The group meets monthly to focus on refugees, homelessness, domestic violence and broader social justice issues.

The Social Justice Group has been working to mitigate the suffering of those affected by homelessness in Sydney. The group supports Teresa House, a project established by Cana Communities. It is a house in Redfern that provides free overnight crisis accommodation for 10 guests, especially for mentally ill and addicted women and men, couples and transgender people who are at risk or simply with nowhere else to go.

St Michael's volunteers have been operating Teresa House on Thursday evenings and overnight since April 2016. Volunteers to support the operation of Teresa House are welcome. All volunteers receive comprehensive training.
